



Pre-consignment is vital to a successful consignment sale.  
Do not take any chances! Mail your paperwork today!

### **Helpful Hints:**

- ☞ Take a few minutes to get your property sale ready - Be creative in displaying.
- ☞ Use information tags or detail sheets when possible to describe your racing parts.
- ☞ Use colored racing tape, pegboard, and/or wire ties to put together your sale displays.

### **Specific Details:**

- ☞ Consignment day is Friday, January 15, 2016, 9:00 AM – 7:00 PM
- ☞ Follow directions to sale site. When arriving watch for “Racer’s Auction” signs.
- ☞ Auction personnel will direct consignors to the unloading area.

### **Consignor Responsibilities:**

- ☞ Upon arriving at the building, consignors must check in at the Office to complete a consignor form. Consignors must present a valid driver’s license or picture identification to consign property.
- ☞ Consignors are responsible for unloading their property from their vehicles and helping with the consignment as it is checked in. All heavy items (blocks, rear ends, machinery, etc.) must be placed on pallets (available at no charge at sale site).
- ☞ In cooperation with State Fire Marshall Laws, consignors must remove their vehicles from the building once the property has been unloaded.
- ☞ Consignors may put a reserve bid (minimum) of \$250.00 or more on any item. However, items with a reserve bid are subject to “NO-SALE” Commission.
- ☞ All property sells on its own merit.
